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ABSTRACT



Short Structured questionnaire was sent to the librarians of different management colleges covered under the study. There are in Jabalpur but present study covers only 10 highly reputed private management colleges in Jabalpur They are as follows:

3.1 Limitations of the study

- Study Covered only highly reputed private management colleges only
- The main concern of study was internet application in house-keeping operation and information services only not other aspects of management college libraries
- Study not covered all the private management collage libraries in Jabalpur
- The Study is based on the questionnaire response survey and personal interviews

4. ANALYSIS

• Internet Connectivity: Internet is most important source of information in libraries to satisfy the different needs of the users.

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Table 1 Shows that out of 10 Libraries 09 (90%) Have internet connectivity and only 01(10%) college library has no facility to use internet it is good sign that greater number of libraries has internet connectivity.

Table 3 depicts that about 50 per cent libraries were providing online access to databases and only 10 per cent libraries were hosting of homepage .it is pathetic that almost 70 per cent libraries are not providing internet based information services to their users.

• Information retrieval and searching: Search engine is one of the most useful tools for accurate and quick information retrieval and searching on internet The mostly used search engine are yahoo,google, rediff,altavista and khoj etc.

Table 5 analysis shows that all the librarians feel that internet has advantage over library. During personal interview 6 (60%) librarian said that internet will replace the libraries in near future while 4 (40%) librarians are not in this favour

• Librarians satisfaction with the internet supporting the library services: As per the satisfaction evaluation of the librarians if they were satisfied with the current state of internet to support the library's services or not following data was obtains.

Table 6 indicates that 50 per cent of librarians were not satisfied with the current status of internet to support the library services whereas only 2(20%) librarians were satisfied and 2 (20%) were less satisfied.

5 FINDINGS

- It is found that 9 (90%) libraries have the internet connectivity.
- It is also found that all the libraries are using internet more or less in house-keeping operation



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- It is bad experience that almost 70% libraries are not providing internet based information services to their users.
- From the study it is clear that yahoo & Google are most commonly used search engines.
- All the librarian feel that internet has advantage over library and majority of librarians i.e.6 (60%) feel the internet will replace the traditional libraries in future.
- It is found that very few librarians i.e. 2 (20%) are satisfied with the current status of internet to support the library services.

CONCLUSION

The study concludes that application of internet in management college libraries is very useful in performing house-keeping operations and information services. But the study shows that private management college libraries in Jabalpur are at the infancy level. Therefore private management college libraries will have to take some constructive steps in this regard.

To promote internet usage in management college libraries, it is a must to organize orientation cum training programmes seminars, workshops etc.on internet application is college libraries and relevant advances in internet and related technologies Also college management should co-operate positively and they should provide sufficient budget to library for ICT implementation

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
